COVID-19 AWARENESS PROGRAMME

COVID-19 transmits when people breathe in air contaminated by droplets and small airborne particles. The risk of breathing these in is highest when people are in close proximity, but they can be inhaled over longer distances, particularly indoors. Transmission can also occur if splashed or sprayed with contaminated fluids, in the eyes, nose or mouth, and, rarely, via contaminated surfaces. People remain contagious for up to 20 days, and can spread the virus even if they do not develop any symptoms

BRAILLE WORLD DAY

The doctrine of human rights has been highly influential within international law and global and regional institutions. The idea of human rights suggests that "if the public discourse of peacetime global society can be said to have a common moral language, it is that of human rights". The strong claims made by the doctrine of human rights continue to provoke considerable scepticism and debates about the content, nature and justifications of human rights to this day. The precise meaning of the term right is controversial and is the subject of continued philosophical debate; while there is consensus that human rights encompasses a wide variety of rights such as the right to a fair trial, protection against enslavement, prohibition of genocide, free speech or a right to education, there is disagreement about which of these particular rights should be included within the general framework of human rights;[1] some thinkers suggest that human rights should be a minimum requirement to avoid the worst-case abuses, while others see it as a higher standard. It has also been argued that

Yoga is the most ancient system of development of the body and the mind. It was practiced thousands of years ago in this country and is being carried out even today. Some say Lord Shiva was its innovator. Our ancestors

practiced it with remarkable success to maintain good physic and to keep mind tranquil.

The eight steps of yoga or limbs (Astanga Yoga), according to Patanjali, are: Yama, niyama, asanas, pranayama, pratyahar, dharna, dhyana ana Samadhi. Yoga means control and discipline, niyama means rules, methods and principle, asanas relate to make physical postures, pranayama is kriyas with air, pratyahar is avoidin undesirable, dhyana is concentration, dhyana is meditation and samadhi is contemplation. Patanjali did not go into details about the eight types of yogas. Therefore more study or research was necessary. The results of further studies were that they were grouped under different categories according to nature: Bhakti yoga, Karma yoga, Jnan yoga and Hatha yoga.

Naturopathy is successful in curing many common and some chronic diseases. Nature cure is a comprehensive term applied to methods of natural forces and the defensive mechanism of the body. It is a distinct system of healing. It is not only very inexpensive and simple but also totally free of harmful side effects.

The nature itself is a healer since it has given us the capacity to fight and overcome diseases. The presence of

germs in the human body is merely a symptom of a disease, not its cause. Many type of bacteria are present in the atmosphere but all persons do not fall victim to hem, because human body has capacity to ward off disease. A person falls sick only when his defences are down.

Naturopathy believes that the correct approach to eating is that a person should "eat to live" and not "live to eat". Eating should be a necessary function as breathing is, but most people regard it as a means of gratifying their desire for the nice things of life.

HINDI DIWAS

The Organization programme for all people awareness for hindi diewas in nationality compromise, usually called the, after drafting committee members and after three years of debate between two opposing camps. To demonstrate the abilities of handicapped children and using those capabilities for shaping his/her career in future.

To stimulate and promote the planning of rehabilitation services and to develop community responsiveness to disabled.

Identification of appropriate curriculum to suit the handicapped children.

Your committee has taken wide exercise of establishing special residential school for M.R. & H.H. at Vaishali district of Bihar, the area which is much affected and sensitive.

Your society had conducted intensive survey on all type of handicapped specially for children, to rehabilitate them and insert education & skill, for their livelihood and social - respect.

Awareness towards pollution/environmental awareness

TRANSGENDER WELFARE PROGRAMME

The heightened levels of violence and abuse that transgender people experience result in unique adverse effects on bodily and mental health. Specifically, in resource-constrained settings where non-discriminatory policies may be limited or not enforced, transgender people may encounter high rates of stigma and violence which are associated with poor health outcomes. Studies in countries of the Global North show higher levels of discrimination and harassment in school, workplace, healthcare services and the family when compared with cisgender populations, situating transphobia as a key health risk factor for the physical and mental health of transgender people.

There is limited data regarding the impact of social determinants of health on transgender and gender non-conforming individuals health outcomes. However, despite the limited data available, transgender and gender non-conforming individuals have been found to be at higher risk of experiencing poor health outcomes and restricted access to health care due to increased risk for violence, isolation, and other types of discrimination both inside and outside the health care setting.

Despite its importance, access to preventive care is also limited by several factors, including discrimination and erasure. A study on young transgender women's access to HIV treatment found that one of the main contributors to not accessing care was the use of incorrect name and pronouns. A meta analysis of the National Transgender Discrimination Survey examined respondents who used the "gender not listed here" option on the survey and their experiences with accessing health care. Over a third of the people who chose that option said that they had avoided accessing general care due to bias and fears of social repercussions

AUTISM AWARENESS DAY

The autism spectrum is a range of neurodevelopmental conditions generally characterized by difficulties in social interactions and communication, repetitive behaviors, intense interests, and unusual responses to sensory stimuli. It is commonly referred to as autism or, in the context of a professional diagnosis, autism spectrum disorder (ASD).

A spectrum disorder is one that can manifest very differently from person to person: any given person with

the disorder is likely to show some but not all of the characteristics associated with it, and may show them to very different degrees. Different autistic people might show strikingly different characteristics, and the same person might also present differently at different times. Historically, the autism spectrum was divided into sub-categories, but questions persisted over the validity of these divisions.
