ACTIVITIES & PROGRAMMES

- With the objectives: -
- To evaluate the children with physical deformities to unfold their full potential.
- To ascertain the medical psycho – social and educational needs of the deformed children for mainstreaming them into the community successfully,
- To assist the children to realize their deformities and help them to over come the deficiencies successfully,
- To demonstrate the abilities of handicapped children and using those capabilities for shaping his/her career in future.
- To stimulate and promote the planning of rehabilitation services and to develop community responsiveness to disabled.

- With herculean challenge & task performed by your Executive Committee, your society succeeded to get finance in shape of grant – in – aid sanctioned in month of March, 2005, from Ministry Social Justice & Empowerment, Government of India for Rs. 3.71 lacks.
- The Ministry had at the plan of society, which resulted into imbalance of cost effectiveness. But your society with consultation of Project Experts is running the project successfully. Your society has written to officials of Ministry about the financial gearing and problems – arising out by their consideration & sanction. The minority's officials are being requested to solve the financial stringment of this project.

- Awareness towards pollution/environmental awareness
- A colourful programme was staged in Dakbanglow Maidan in which songs plays and shows were presented based on safe drinking water, plantation, diseases like malaria, filaria, cholera, dysentery and preservation of new and pollution free toilet.
- Literacy programme



- Our volunteers visited the villages, specially in backward areas an impressed to send their children to school in any condition where in formal or non-formal education centre.
- Cultural programme
- Very interesting songs, play with jokes were presented in the street corner of the villagers of the Block by Janta of the organisation in which people became aware of it and collective assurance were delivered therein.
- Seminars on child labour
- On the eve of International Child Labour Day, on 30th of April 2021 child labours have been identified with their parents were called for seminar in which they were made know to the evils of the child labour and were impressed to send their children to schools where formal or nor-formal education are being given.

STREET PLANTATION PROGRAMME

- According to the society plantation is need of time assistance of preservation of environment and doing plantation work. Society also organise a free distribution of nursery plant camp at Sandalpur area in Patna district and



distributed nutritional plants between the people. A training programme organizes through the society for farmer. In this training trained to farmer for use new technique of agriculture work.

WATER AWARNNESS PROGRAMME

- In the category of programmes for asset creation and infrastructure development in rural areas your society plays a critical role. Under these plays your



society working for creation of assets like rural roads, village tanks, water-harvesting structures, panchayat ghars, anganwadi, buildings etc. Accelerated Rural Water supply Programme and Central Rural Sanitation Programmes are two other programmes meant for safe drinking water and better hygienic living in rural areas.

Because of the programmes “the beneficiaries have better access to safe drinking water, better house to live in, greater access to health and educational facilities, improvement in the quality of life and have developed greater self-confidence and security in life including improvement in economic status and social recognition.

This programme organised your society every year in different month for 15 days in different area. Other main feature of this programme would be “Digestive Health Week” programme for creating awareness about gastrointestinal and liver diseases, the public awareness initiative seeks to educate people about various diseases, their prevention and optimal treatment. As part of the initiative, the programme will create awareness through posters, slide shows and audiovisual presentations. In this programme your society organised a free digestive health check-up camp and two public interest lectures on “Prevention of Gastrointestinal Cancers” and “Facts and Myths About Jaundice”.

MEDITATION AND HALTH AWARENESS

Naturopathy is successful in curing many common and some chronic diseases.

Nature cure is a comprehensive term applied to methods of natural forces and the defensive mechanism of the body. It is a distinct system of healing. It is not only

very inexpensive and simple but also totally free of harmful side effects.



The nature itself is a healer since it has given us the capacity to fight and overcome diseases. The presence of germs in the human body is merely a symptom of a disease, not its cause. Many type of bacteria are present in the atmosphere but all persons do not fall victim to hem, because human body has capacity to ward off disease. A person falls sick only when his defences are down.

Naturopathy believes that the correct approach to eating is that a person should "eat to live" and not "live to eat". Eating should be a necessary function as breathing is, but most people regard it as a means of gratifying their desire for the nice things of life.

Our society organized these programmes with support of Local contribution, membership fees, donation and member's contributions

COVID-19 AWARENESS PROGRAMME

COVID-19 transmits when people breathe in air contaminated by droplets and small airborne particles. The risk of breathing these in is highest when people are in close proximity, but they can be inhaled over longer distances, particularly indoors. Transmission can also occur if splashed or sprayed with contaminated fluids, in the eyes, nose or mouth, and, rarely, via contaminated surfaces. People remain contagious for up to 20 days, and can spread the virus even if they do not develop any symptoms

SKILL DEVELOPMENT TRAINING PROGRAMME

The organisation conducted the programme in HAVERI District of KARNATAKA State. The main goal is to create opportunities, space and scope for the development of the talents of the Indian youth and to develop more of those sectors which have already been put under skill development for the last so many years and also to identify new sectors for skill development. The new programme aims at providing training and skill development to youth of our country by covering each and every village. Various schemes are also proposed to achieve this objective.

The emphasis is to skill the youths in such a way so that they get employment and also improve entrepreneurship.

Provides training, support and guidance for all occupations that were of traditional type like carpenters, cobblers, welders, blacksmiths, masons, nurses, tailors, weavers etc.

More emphasis will be given on new areas like real estate, construction, transportation, textile, gem industry, jewellery designing, banking, tourism and various other sectors, where skill development is inadequate .

VOCATIONAL TRAINING PROGRAMME

society organizes vocational training programme for welfare women, child and youths belonging to the informal economy. It is not just an organization but also a confluence of three movements- labour, self-reliance and self-employment. Our society started vocational training programme to encourage self-reliance and self-employment for women and youths who were unemployed and searching job. In this programme society started all educated and uneducated persons in view of their requirements. Under vocational training programme our society-started computer training, typing, handcrafting, tailoring-sewing, weaving, painting, T.V., Transistor and Tape-recorder repairing programmes.

HIV/AIDS AWARENESS PROGRAMME

India is sitting on an HIV/AIDS “time-bomb” and the epidemic could soon become like it in Africa unless immediate steps are taken to accelerate efforts to stem it. This is the warning from the head of an international survey agency. “The HIV/AIDS deadly



disease in India is extremely grave. It is ticking time bomb. The epidemic is rising rapidly and could soon get out of control, unless the response was scaled up massively.”

The trajectory of the epidemic in India is the same as that in Africa and though the current level of the epidemic here may be 10 to 15 years behind that in Africa, it may not be long before it catches up. The catastrophic situation being faced in Botswana and other parts of Southern Africa “is just a vision of the future” that India could face. In KARNATAKA, for instance, no one knows how many persons are affected.

Your society accepted the need participating of community and social workers for minimize this problem. Without participating

and involvement of the corporate sector, the NGOs and community-based organizations the Government would not be able to tackle the problem all by itself and more effectively in anti-AIDS programmes.

OLD AGE HOME

To empower and improve the quality of life of older person, keeping in view diverse necessities such concern of the family, health inter-generation relationship, equipping to face old age, productive aging, shelter and health needs this old age home programme, was under taken by your society. 55 Persons aged 60 years and above, particularly the windows, infirm and destitute are kept under constant care. Your organization is much hopeful with the result of this programme and enthusiastic to take wide programme in this regard.

SC/ST WELFARE PROGRAMME

The project management committee of SOCIETY has been reported various cases related to SC/ST in the districts. The matter was discussed in the managing committee meeting. The matter was resolved positively to open and run to provide facilities to SC/ST. In several schemes including health, education was taken up among the SC/ST classes of people and we helped and we helped them avail of government aids etc. in this direction.

WOMEN AND CHILD EDUCATION PROG.

Your society organised development programme for women and children. Main objective of this programme for the development of women and children in rural areas



is to improve the lot of rural women through the creation of income-generating activities in a district. Many rural areas of

Bihar/Jharkhand states are covered under this programme by society. It envisages formation of groups of 10-15 rural women each for carrying on income-generating activities. Under this programme society also facilitate to literate and organised vocational training centre where society started training programme for weaving, tailoring, handicrafts products making etc. to lead better quality of life.

RURAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

Society organised many programme for rural development and working for upliftment of the life and livelihood of rural India. It aims to promote a single window delivery need based services in the areas of education, health, nutrition, weather, environment, agriculture and livelihoods to rural women and men. According to society developmental programme for rural areas is necessity to up gradation of economic, social and gender equity. Society helps to enhance ecological and livelihood security and accelerate human development and quality of life by taking the benefits of the space age for improving the productivity, profitability and sustainability of agriculture and for generating value addition on farm and non-farm employment.

HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE PROG.

India is developing country. Every year many women are dead during the pregnancy period for the reason that poor nutrients and



negligence of health care. In pregnancy period women required special care. Due to poorness and backwardness of the people

maternal mortality rate is very high in India. To bringing down the maternity mortality rate to zero percent and improving institutional childbirth, your society especially for women organised free health check-up PROGRAMME in many places of Patna District. The programme aims at building public-government partnership, involving experts from the field of Obstetrics and Gynaechology. The programme involves provision of free WELFARE to the expectant mothers, covering both antenatal and postnatal care on the first week of each month in different areas. The services would include blood tests, TT injections, Hepatitis injection, free distribution of iron tablets and other medicines along with regular check-up. In this programme your society also working attached with newborn child-care and working for immunisation, food care, health care etc. programmes. In this programme near about 200 women had benefited of different areas of Patna district. In this programme your society also organised quiz programme and prize distribution programme main theme were care of women in pregnant period & childcare below the age of 5 years. The main feature of the programme held by your society was lecturers by senior consultants, question/answer interactive session and distribution of free medicines.

GIRLD EDUCATION PROGRAMME

Education especially for women is an important agent of socialization, and instrument of social transformation, and a channel of social mobility and equity. Education of



girls and women has to be a universal movement for their empowerment, for changing current stereo-typed and replacing the existing structures.

Within an overall orientation toward girls' education, your organisation is running "SAHAJ SIKSHA" Programme being one of the parts of overall strategy of universalisation of Elementary Education (UEE). SAHAJ SIKSHA programme is an alternative path to children who for different reasons cannot attend primary school e.g. girls who have to look after their younger siblings and attend to other domestic chores, working children etc.

Your, organisation is organizing regular centre in HAVERI ALL Panchayats .

ROAD SAFETY ADVOCACY PROGRAMME

Day by day increasing accidental cases on the road it is big problems of the Govt., Society & People at a glance we can give answers in simple word reason is increasing rush of the traffic on the road. But according to society it is not facts of the cases of accidents. Many people don't know the rules of traffic. Some people are only maintainin g rules of traffic some are who they know rules of traffic but not maintain on the road. We have organized seminar and awareness camps on the above topic for the aware and teach the traffic rules.

YOGA AND NATUROPATHY PROGRAMME

Yoga described as wisdom in work of skilful living amongst activities harmony and moderation. The word yoga is derived from the Sanskrit root “Yug” meaning to bind join attach and yoke, to direct the concentrate one’s attention on, to use and apply. It also means union or communion. It is the true union of our ‘will’ with the ‘will’ of God. ‘It means the disciplining of the intellect, the mind, the amotion, the will, which that Yoga presupposes, it means a poise of the soul which enables one to look at life in all its aspects evenly.’



Yoga could the mind, intellect and self (ahamkara) are under control, freed from restless desire, so that they rest in the spirit within, a man becomes a yukta-one in communion with God. Today’s the life of men is restless and living with harassments. Men have no time for their fitness maintain. So society organised yoga programme in many areas to teach people about Yoga, “Yoga-a way of Life”. Society also teaches about naturopathy for joyful life of people.

SWACHH BHARAT ABHIYAN

The core objectives of the first phase of the mission were to reduce open defecation and improve management of municipal solid waste in both urban and rural areas.[citation needed] Elimination of open defecation was to be achieved through construction of individual household level toilets (often twin pit pour flush pit latrines), toilets and public toilets. For improving solid waste management, cities were encouraged to prepare detailed project reports that are bankable and have a financial model. The second phase on the other hand focuses on sustaining gains of the first phase and improving management of the solid and liquid wastes.

YOUTH EDUCATION DEVELOPMENT PROG.

A major problem faced by educated Youth in rural areas, is the lack of locally available employment opportunities. It results in frustration and consequent migration. If rural youth get adequate opportunities for taking up gainful ventures at the



local level, they would not only be able to improve their well being but also contribute to the economy. Self-employment is a possible solution to this problem. A small step in a remote village in the country, proved to be a significant milestone in this direction. Your society aims to transform rural youth to acquire a productive identity through short duration interventions, which include motivation and training. The facilities are provided free of cost to the trainees. Your society caters to youth in the age group

of 18 to 35 years. A basic education is desirable, preferably upto 10th standard. However, an aptitude to take up self-employment ventures is a must. Your society is particular in identifying this aptitude while selecting the candidates. This is done by including a meeting with the parents or guardians to ascertain their commitment to the venture being set up by the candidate. This provides the selectors with valuable clues regarding the potential of the candidate and the support that he is likely to receive from his parents.

Your organisation employs a path breaking approach of training youth for self-employment ventures. In the first phase, the achievement motivation and entrepreneurship competency of the candidates is developed. The second phase concentrates on developing technical skills. The training also includes guidance regarding project identification, market surveys and familiarizing with schemes of banks and other support organisations. Management and Marketing inputs are also provided.

The process of training is quite rigorous. The exercise provides them with increased self-confidence and also develops their abilities in interactions with people in groups. The exercises provided to the candidates help in identifying their entrepreneurship potential and developing the same.

The methodology employed includes acclimatization through micro-lab approach, lectures and role-play, business simulation exercises, experience sharing, field visits and interface with role models. The faculty employed comprises of locally available talent from banks, academicians, skilled technicians and development administrators. Some trainees who had passed out in earlier courses are also invited for lectures to guide and help future batches.

Another innovative taken by your society, has been introduction of Bazaar to support trainees by providing them with marketing outlets at various fairs for their products. Your organisation has also decided to provide information on Trade fairs to their entrepreneurs to encourage them to participate in such fairs.

WOMEN EMPOWERMENT PROGRAMME

In Indian culture and civilization, the girl child represents beauty, auspiciousness and prosperity. She is worshipped as Dawn, the bringer of hope. The beautiful dancer of Mohenjo-Daro indicates a highly sophisticated culture. She is the mother of humankind. The position of women started deteriorating after the first millennia. Though our constitution and many other legislative acts have promoted gender equality, their status continues to be low. The empowerment of women concerns women gaining control and power over their own lives. It involves awareness raising, building self-confidence, expansion of choices, increased access to and control over resources. Empowerment should come from within, women empower themselves. Inputs to promote the empowerment of women should facilitate the articulation of their needs and priorities and more active role in promoting these needs and interests. Women have a crucial role to play in the modern society.

The gender mainstreaming strategy, evolved in the 1980's and adapted by the countries all over the world, is aimed at making the goal of gender equality central to all development activities. In our country, there is a great upsurge in awareness about women's rights among all sections of society. The developmental programmes and policies give emphasis to improving women's social status. In spite of urbanisation and industrialisation our culture and economy are predominantly agrarian, rural based. So empowering women, who are the backbone of our agrarian economy, is a sure path to achieve major economic gains.

CULTURAL PROGRAMME

The link between extension and research services needs to be strengthened. This will be improving information flow to researchers about farmers' needs and to farmers about new technologies. With the globalisation of Indian economy, there are several aspects of agricultural development where careful precautions are essential. Seed is one of them. Availability of seeding material at the right time and with reasonable price is critical for the success of agriculture sector. The rise in agricultural production in the 70s and 80s in India could be attributed mainly to the use of high yielding seeds. According to

the society, the Indo-American Hybrid Seeds, a rise in agricultural production can be made possible by the use of hybrid seeds.

LITERACY PROGRAMME

Education is a prime determinant of human development. Progress of a community in education may be viewed from several angles and hence different indices of educational achievement may be used. The conventional indices include (i) effective literacy rate (ii) primary school enrolment rate (iii) drop-out rate at the primary level (iv) mean years of schooling at the primary level (v) pupil- teacher ratio and (vi) distance of schools from place of residence.
