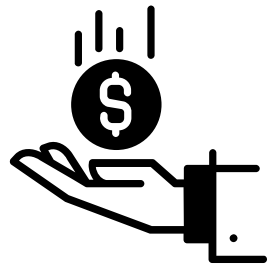

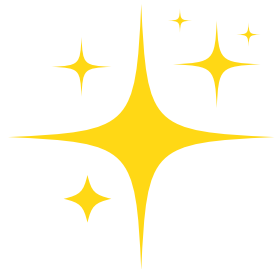
MENSTRUAL HEALTH & HYGIENE MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

The program aimed to educate adolescent girls and women on proper menstrual hygiene management and provide practical solutions for the disposal of sanitary materials. As part of this initiative, 300 sanitary napkins were distributed for free to underprivileged students, ensuring better menstrual health and hygiene practices.
